Jessica Hansen & Lakeside Little League

aseball has always been a part of Jessica Hansen's life. Growing up, she watched her grandmother stay deeply involved in her kids' sports and community activities, a lesson in service and connection that stuck with her. Today, Jessica and other league volunteers aim to keep improving the program while helping ensure that every child who steps on the field has a great experience and every family feels part of something bigger.

Jessica and her husband, Shaun, moved to Granite Bay more than a decade ago with their children and quickly found a home at Lakeside. She started out as a team parent, helping organize snacks, schedules, and team events, and before long, her involvement grew. In 2018, she joined the league's Board of Directors, helping bring to life memorable events like Opening Day, Denim &







Diamonds, The Mom's Game, and the Adult Home Run Derby. Soon after, she stepped into an official events role, helping bring the annual Hit-a-Thon to life - now the league's biggest fundraiser of the year. Since taking on event leadership, Jessica has helped raise nearly \$500,000 to support Lakeside Little League's programs, facility upgrades, and player opportunities — a testament to the power of community involvement.

Jessica still plans, coordinates, and runs all Lakeside's events while managing responsibilities as Vice President of Administration, a role she's held since 2021. If those weren't enough tasks, Jessica also runs the league's website and social media platforms, keeping players, families, and the community up to date and engaged. All the roles she's held have helped Jessica realize how vital this organization is, not just for the youth involved, but for the area as well. "The most rewarding part is seeing kids grow in confidence, character, and sportsmanship," Jessica says. "Baseball is the vehicle, but the life lessons, friendships, and sense of belonging are what last. Knowing I had a small hand in creating those opportunities is incredibly fulfilling."

Since 1981, Lakeside Little League has provided local youth the opportunity

to play baseball in a fun, convivial atmosphere. Those involved with Lakeside Little League are eager to recruit new volunteers, whether they have a passion for baseball or simply want to support local youth. Families can step in as coaches, team parents, and volunteers who can help during events or assist on field days. There are also roles available on the board. "More volunteers mean stronger programs," Jessica explains. "With more hands helping, we can expand events, improve facilities, and create more opportunities for kids. It's not just about baseball—it's about investing in the next generation." Local businesses can impact the league through team sponsorship or contributing to fundraisers. The continued focus is on growing opportunities for players of all skill levels, enhancing facilities, and strengthening the volunteer network that makes Lakeside special.





For Jessica, the last decade of being involved with this league have been extremely rewarding. She hopes other Granite Bay locals will join in to help create a stronger, more connected network around youth baseball. "Lakeside Little League is about more than baseball—it's about community, teamwork, and giving kids a place to grow," Jessica says. "We'd love for more families and local businesses to get involved and continue building on that tradition."

Buccola Pets



Scouting America Troop 121

or more than five decades, Scouting America Troop 121 has served the Granite Bay area, inspiring young people to become leaders, stewards, and active members of their community. With members from Granite Bay, Loomis, Roseville, and Orangevale, the troop provides a welcoming environment where youth ages 11–17 can challenge themselves, build confidence, and learn the value of service.

Originally known as Boy Scouts of America, the organization changed its name to *Scouting America* to better reflect its inclusive mission. The Scouts BSA program, which opened to girls in 2019, continues the tradition of adventure and





character development that has been at the heart of Scouting for 115 years. Today, Troop 121 includes 62 youth and 52 adult volunteers, all dedicated to upholding the Scout Oath and Law while helping young people prepare for life. Scouting begins as early as K/1st grade. Pack 31, which meets at Oakhills and Ridgeview Elementary, is essential to Troop 121.

Troop 121's impact reaches far beyond its meetings at Cavitt Middle School and summer camps at Folsom Lake. The Scouts lead community service projects year-round, from cleaning up local parks to improving schools by painting benches, basketball courts, and playground maps, and building planter boxes and shelving. They also perform honor guard and flag ceremonies for Gold Star Families and local school boards, teaching respect and gratitude through action.

The troop's annual service traditions are among its most meaningful community

contributions. On January 3–4, Scouts will once again offer *Christmas tree pickup*, collecting trees placed curbside by 9:00 a.m. Donations can be made by check to Troop 121, and all trees are recycled into mulch for soil conservation. Then, on March 14, the Scouts will participate in *Scouting for Food*, encouraging residents to leave bags or boxes of canned goods at the curb by 9:00 a.m. These donations go to local food banks, helping neighbors in need.

Beyond community service, Troop 121 fosters leadership and lifelong friendships. The troop is youth-led, allowing Scouts to plan their own camping, backpacking, and rafting trips—activities that develop independence and teamwork. Many members go on to achieve the rank of Eagle Scout; in fact, more than 370 Eagle Scouts have emerged from Troop 121, each one embodying the spirit of service and perseverance that defines the organization.

Looking ahead, Scouting America

continues to evolve while honoring its core values. The introduction of merit badges in technology, coding, robotics, and artificial intelligence reflects Scouting's commitment to preparing young people for a rapidly changing world. The upcoming banquet will celebrate the anniversary of Scouting and mark a leadership milestone as a new Scoutmaster is inducted, continuing a proud legacy of mentorship and service. After six years as a Scoutmaster and 24 years as a Troop and Pack leader, Mitch Gorsen will lead the induction of the next Scoutmaster at the anniversary of Scouting banquet on February 1 at 5:30 p.m., at Cavitt, to which all troop alumni are invited. Gorsen will continue to serve Troop 121 as the Chartered Organization Representative of the Rotary Club of Granite Bay and a merit badge counselor. Many members of the Rotary are former Scouts.
